### **Disclaimer:**

- It is still possible that we may NOT travel in 2021, depending on the severity of COVID-19
- However, it is impossible to travel, if we do not start now!
- All listed costs are approximations based on typical increases seen by the travel company. We have estimated it on the high end, but the cost could be slightly more or less!
- All FUNDRAISED money, in the case of a cancellation, would be filtered into the band boosters as would a typical fundraiser. We CANNOT and WILL NOT return these funds to individuals
- If parents pay out of pocket, and we have not yet paid the travel company, then and only then will money be refunded.
- If we have already paid the travel company, this situation will be entirely in their hands, but I would not expect to get it back.
- We will likely not make our first payment to the travel company until the 2021-22 school year begins.

\*\*Participants may want to plan on bringing an extra \$5.00-\$10.00 depending on how much they plan to eat. Disney Meal Cards are good all week. Any money you do not use will carry over until departure. Additional spending money for souvenirs or vending machines at the hotel is up to each participant.

### My Disney Experience App:

The My Disney Experience App is a great resource that includes park maps, wait times, fast passes, and mobile ordering for meals. Highly recommended!

### Instruments:

All instruments and equipment must have student's name and address on them. Music & Arts will be providing ID tags for students who do not currently have them for their instruments. All instruments should be cleaned and polished BEFORE the final rehearsal on Monday. Mouthpieces, valve oil, reeds, etc. should not be left loose in cases. It would also be in parents' best interest to make sure privately owned instruments are covered by homeowner's insurance for both damage and loss.

### Music:

All music, cadences, and routines for the Disney parade performance MUST be memorized. Students, including auxiliaries, will be assessed and graded individually by a director prior to March 18th.

### **Medical:**

Notify your chaperone immediately of any illness. They will contact a staff member and/or our trip nurses, TBD and TBD. TBD, will also be helping handle all medications. In the parks, you will be shown to the First Aid Station. There will be a copy of emergency medical forms there if a chaperone needs to access them. Our trip nurses and pharmacist will also be responsible for dispensing all prescription medications to students. Please inform Mrs. Billman if any insurance/emergency medical information has changed since the fall.

### **Chaperones:**

Chaperones will be assisting with student supervision on the bus, in the hotel, and in the Disney parks. Chaperones will be in charge of evening room checks and morning wake-up calls at the hotel. They will also be checking luggage before departure from Jackson on Monday and will oversee the check-out procedure on Friday morning. Chaperones are students' first contact if any assistance is needed in parks.

Chaperones are VOLUNTEERING their time to ensure your safety. **STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO SHOW ALL CHAPERONES, PARENTS, AND STAFF THE UTMOST RESPECT.**

### **Hotel:**

All room assignments are to be followed for the entire stay at the hotel. A copy of the rooming list will be posted in the band room and distributed upon departure. Each room will have a room captain(see asterisk by names) who will be issued the two room keys to your room. All persons are responsible for the care of the room. Keep all volumes, including television and other electronics, down to a reasonable level. Remember, we are not the only guests staying at the Spring Hill Suites.

Curfew is the time immediately before *lights out*. During this time, students will be required to be in their room and remain there for the night. Students may use this time to prepare for a good night's sleep. *Lights out* will vary depending on our day's schedule. The staff will determine a reasonable curfew when we return to the hotel each night. At *lights out*, chaperones will do rounds for bed checks.

In addition to the band staff and chaperones, there will be hotel security staff and additional private security guards hired for our band members in our hallways to ensure a good night's sleep. Students are not permitted to leave their room after the stated times and doors must be kept completely closed after the final check. Chaperones will tape in students at *Lights out*, and no student will be permitted to leave the room until chaperones come around for morning wake-up calls. If you have an

emergency that requires you to leave the room you must immediately go to your chaperone. If a chaperone finds tape broken in the morning disciplinary action will be taken with the possibility of students being sent home.

During hotel free times, chaperones and staff will be located throughout the building. Students are not to enter, or allow to enter, any person not affiliated with Jackson. No girls will be permitted to enter boys' rooms, and no boys will be permitted to enter girls' rooms. Hotel lounges and patios may be utilized for co-ed socializing. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action. Students may only utilize the hotel pool at the discretion of the director. Mr. Rex will make the decision each night when we arrive back at the hotel if students will be permitted to use the pool.

During the final room check on Friday morning, all room occupants will remain in your room after breakfast until a chaperone has checked it for condition and possible clothing/personal items.

### **Discipline:**

Everyone is expected to act courteously and responsibly at all times. There is a **zero tolerance policy** with regard to any student who fails to comply with the trip rules. Failure to comply with these rules **will result in the student being sent home**. This would include the student taking the preferred transportation home, unaccompanied. The cost of these travel expenses will be the responsibility of the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s). No refunds will be forthcoming for any portion of the trip missed as a result of the termination.

### **RULES**

1. The trip to Orlando, Florida is a school and band approved function. All Jackson High School, Jackson City Schools, and Jackson Band rules and policies will be in effect and must be followed at all times.
2. Possession, purchase and/or use of alcoholic beverages, drugs, and smoking/vaping **WILL NOT** be tolerated.
3. Band members will behave *responsibly* at all times.
4. **NO** inappropriate behavior will be tolerated. After one warning, the participant(s) will be separated and remain with a chaperone. At the second warning, the participant(s) will be sent home immediately at their parent's or legal guardian's expense, and will remain with a chaperone until their departure.
5. Students must be on time for all check-ins, meeting times, and room curfews.

6. Students are responsible for the condition and contents of their rooms. Any cost or damages to the room or contents will be shared equally by those students occupying the room.
7. Boys **ARE NOT** permitted in girls' rooms, and girls **ARE NOT** permitted in boys' rooms. Co-ed social time is only permitted in a common area with chaperones present.

**Final Thoughts:**

- This trip should be a safe, enjoyable, and memorable trip for everyone.
- “Please” and “Thank you” should be part of your vocabulary every day.
- Have patience, but also complete tasks requested of you in an expedient manner.
- Plan ahead! **BE ON TIME**. Scheduled times must be met. We cannot wait for late people. It is unfair to waste the time of the group, because you did not plan ahead.
- Help each other; remind each other of report times, rules, safety, etc.
- Get adequate sleep. The performance will require your best effort. We are performing and representing Jackson to an international audience. You will need your rest!
- Eat healthy meals, especially breakfast, and drink lots of water.
- Wear sunscreen **AT ALL TIMES**.
- We are looking forward to having a very safe, enjoyable, and memorable trip together.
- Represent yourself in a manner that will make everyone proud of a job well done. You are representing your Band, School, and Community!
